

HOW TO APPLY

Students living anywhere in the county can apply to this school. Please check the district website at www.pcsb.org for more information. There are entrance criteria to apply for this magnet school.

TRANSPORTATION

Arterial bus transportation (buses that operate on main roads with a limited number of stops) is provided to students who live more than two miles from the school. Magnet bus stop locations may require that parents drive their children to and from the stop.

MANDATORY MODIFIED DRESS CODE

A modified dress code is mandatory at Tyrone Middle School. All shirts must be solid in color. They must fit neatly and not be oversized or undersized. 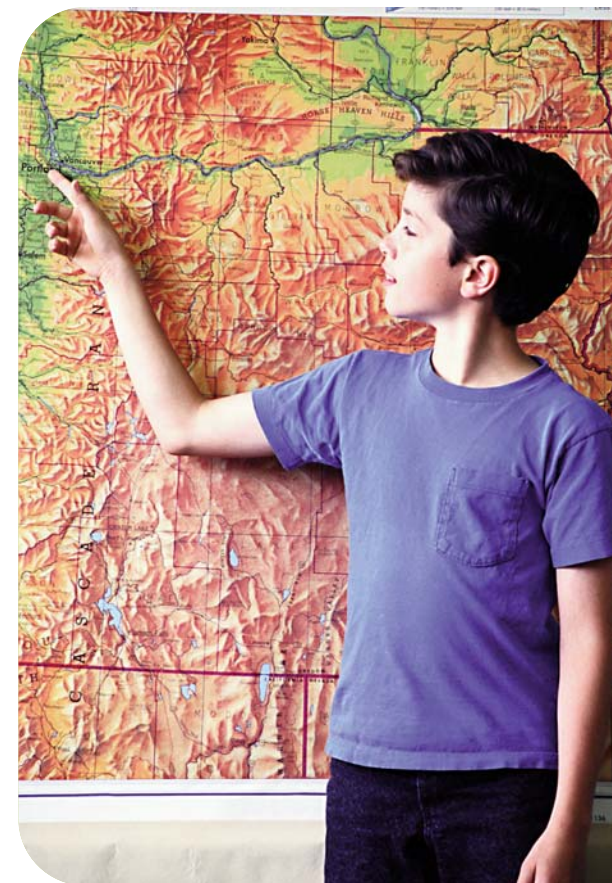
