Bell Schedule & School Hours


□ School opens at 9 a.m. and students can report to the field or to café for breakfast.

On a "B" day, Black Knights attend class periods 5,6,7,8



Solution 1st Day Procedures

Before I arrive school:

- Make sure I have supplies (pen/pencil, paper)
- I am following school dress code policy
- If I ride a bus, I have my bus route and location recorded
- I have on my learning brain and a positive attitude!

When I arrive to school:

- Report to the café for (free) breakfast or the back handball court to get assistance to locate my classroom, if needed.
- Listen to instructions









- Lunches are by grade level. During the first week of school, the lunch times may vary slightly in time as we get everyone settled in classes.
- Every student is provided with free lunch or you may bring your own lunch. Snacks will be sold during lunch, but not during the first few weeks of school.
- Note: <u>Eating in classrooms is not permitted.</u>

Dress Code Policy

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We know that Black Knights come dressed to impress, but just as a reminder:

- NO clothes with excessive/inappropriate holes, no sagging pants, no halter tops, no legging, no short shorts, no bandanas, no sunglasses, no bedroom slippers or pajamas.
- All shirts must have sleeves, be free of offensive language, symbols, images. Cleavage and midriff must be covered.

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Students must remember to keep all electronic devices turned off or on silent during school hours. Students must report to their grade level office to call home. Students calling parents/guardians from cell phones for pick up, medications, etc. poses a safety concern. We are responsible for your child's safety at school. Use of Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, recording teachers and/or students, etc. is not permitted during school hours and can result in confiscation of electronic devices and possible discipline.





Teachers will provide students with hall passes to:

- Use the bathroom (No pass zone during first or last 10 minutes of class)
- Visit the office to call home, medication, or meet with 6th grade office staff (AP, guidance, clerk, etc.)



- All students are expected to come to school everyday with appropriate supplies such as a pen, pencil, and paper. Also the Azalea Middle School binder (provided by school) and their Azalea Middle School agenda.
 Students may carry a backpack with them to school.
- Students are expected to purchase a lock (\$2.00) for hallway lockers. Construction flexibility
- If students are taking P.E. they are expected to purchase a lock (\$2.00) and dress out for P.E. everyday in a white tee shirt and black shorts.

Bullying Prevention

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- Azalea Middle School takes bullying very seriously.
- Pinellas County Schools defines bullying as "being exposed, repeatedly and over time, to negative actions on the part of one or more students as defined by: power differential with physical size, strength, or status, the intent to harm, and the situation being repeated "(Pinellas County Schools, 2004).



What does AMS do about bullying?

- Students who are aware of potential bullying should report to any adult on campus who will refer them to their grade level house to fill out an incident report which outlines specific details of the incident(s) or report on online <u>http://www.pcsb.org/azalea-ms</u> (Site shortcuts) Report bullying or harassment
- School Counselor will work alongside the Administrator to identify potential witnesses, to investigate the report and keep the students' families informed of disposition and actions being taken.
- If bullying is founded, students will be referred for discipline based on the individual circumstances.
- If the incident is other than bullying, other interventions will be implemented such as peer mediation and counseling.
- If you suspect that your student is being bullied, please contact your School Counselor discuss your situation.


