They also compete along with the Drill team during drill meets.



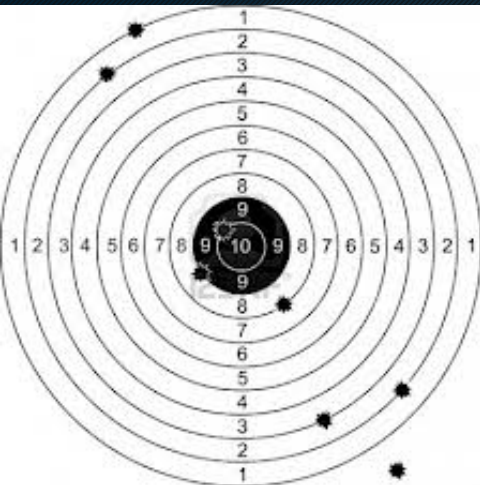
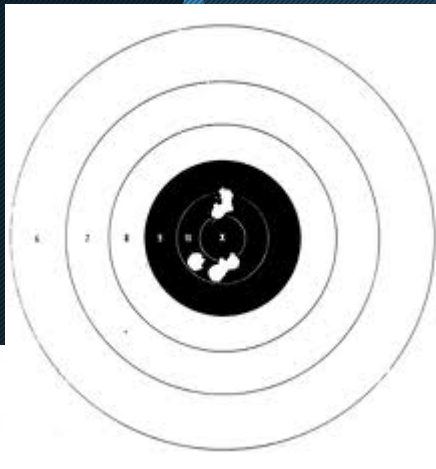
# Rifle Team

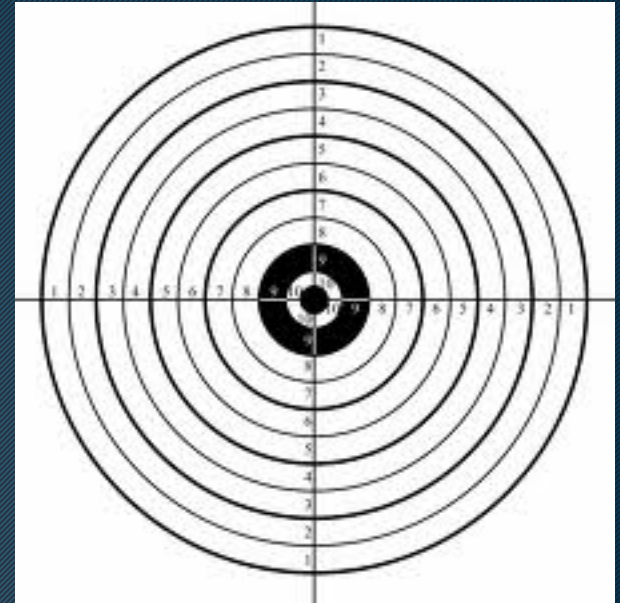
To become a member, one must pass a written test that covers range safety. One must also obtain parental consent to shoot.

# **Academic Team**

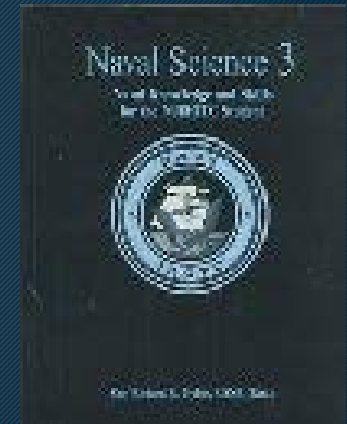
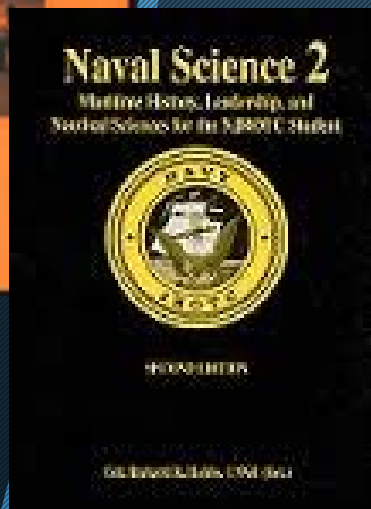
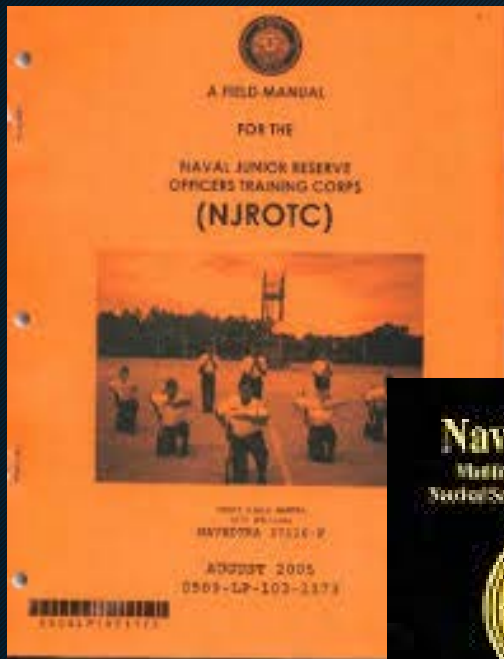
