Level II Screening – Volunteers Questions and Answers

1. Who needs a Level II background check?

All volunteers require a background screening, according to Pinellas County School Board policies. Those who have unsupervised contact with students also require a more extensive Level II background check.

2. What is a Level II background check?

Level 2 background checks involve fingerprint-based checks for statewide criminal history records through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and national criminal history records through the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

3. What is the process to obtain a Level II background check?

- Prior to obtaining a Level II background check, all volunteers must be registered and background-check approved according to Pinellas County School Guidelines mentioned above. This process will take 48 to 72 hours.
- After approval, volunteers who require a Level II background check can visit the EZFingerPrints site, <u>http://www.ezfingerprints.com</u>, to set an appointment for fingerprinting.
 - EZFingerPrints also accepts walk-ins at their Clearwater site.
 - Each volunteer should bring a government-issued photo ID and know his/her Social Security number.

 - A minimum of 10 volunteers must be signed up prior to scheduling a school site fingerprint session.
- All fingerprint approvals will take 24 to 72 hours.
- Approvals will be sent to the Office of Strategic Partnerships.
- The volunteer's profile will be updated with the Level II status in Focus.
- The Office of Strategic Partnerships will be responsible for providing all Level II badges.

4. If the volunteer has been Level II cleared do they have to be Level II screened again?

If the volunteer currently has a Level II clearance they will need to provide a copy of the Level II badge/card or VECHS/FDLE paperwork to: The Office of Strategic Partnerships, 301 Fourth Street, Largo, and FL 33770 - 727-588-6000 x 1853

5. How much does a Level II background check cost?

a. The cost is <u>\$48.00</u> for all walk-ins and or appointments at EZFingerPrints and <u>\$51.00</u> for EZFingerPrints to travel to a school location.

6. Who is responsible for the fingerprint costs?

The volunteer

7. What policy states volunteers need a Level II screening?

Pursuant to School Board Policy 9180, volunteers who have unsupervised contact with students must be Level II screened.

8. Do supervised volunteers need a Level II screening?

No

9. Do mentors and tutors need to be Level II screened?

No, but each needs to be supervised by a PCS employee.

10. Is it ever okay for a volunteer who has not been Level II screened to be unsupervised

According to School Board policy, this should only happen infrequently, in unanticipated situations.

11. Do students who are driving other students to school-sponsored events need to be Level II screened?

No. Please follow the current school board policy regarding student drivers. 2340 - FIELD TRIPS AND OTHER DISTRICT-SPONSORED TRIPS
