Hello Montessori families, We're ready to invite new Montessori families to kindergarten for the next school year. The DAP application period has ended and we'll invite families to accept our program February 4-11. We have 4 siblings who applied for kindergarten. We don't have any openings in grades 1-5 for next year at this time.

You may have wondered:

What is the focus of Montessori education?

The focus of our education system is the development of materials, educational techniques, and observations which support the natural development of the child. In our public school Montessori, the students are taught the state standards using the Montessori method. The teacher in the Montessori classroom serves less as an "instructor" and more as a guide and facilitator. Children are encouraged to "learn how to learn", thus gaining independence and self-confidence.

How will my child adjust to a traditional classroom in 6th grade?

Montessori students develop a love of learning and use their strengths in order to take in new information. The students take their organization skills and their ability to meet deadlines into the new environment. There will be some adjustments to the learning environment; however, the desire to explore new academic avenues can be met within the traditional classroom if the teacher is enthusiastic and provides the opportunity for learning. The sense of discovery will differ when lessons are presented to the whole group instead of allowing the students the joy of discovering new information through their own work.

Volunteers Needed

Studies show that parental involvement and involvement by members of the community in a child's education is one of the most important factors in raising student self-esteem and academic achievement. Moreover, most experts agree that parental involvement should go beyond parent's attending teacher conferences and open house. We realize however, that each of our families and members of the community are unique – with its own priorities, needs, talents and time constraints—and we try to provide as many different opportunities for volunteer involvement as possible.



There are a number of areas your help is needed including the Parent Teacher Association, chaperone field trips, media center and office.

In order to be in compliance with the Pinellas County School System and State of Florida laws, we need for each volunteer and/or mentor to complete a Volunteer Registration Form. A copy of your driver's license or legal id is also needed. We will be happy to make a copy of your official identification in the school office. Both sides of the Volunteer Registration Form must be completed and include your signature and date, as well as a copy of your legal identification.

It takes approximately two weeks for the Volunteer Registration Form to be processed. I will be happy to notify you when the form has been approved.

The first time you volunteer after approval of the registration form, please bring your driver's license so that we may log your name into the Pinellas County School's badge pass program. When you volunteer, also please log your volunteer hours on the computer in the school's front office. We will be happy to help you with the log-in process. Volunteer hours should be recorded each time you volunteer.

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Classroom Update

December 17th at 9:30 a.m., Mrs. Freeman's & Mrs. Forte's second grade classes marched a half mile to the Gulfport Public Library. Students and teachers paraded down 22nd Avenue accompanied by a parent volunteer. Co-teacher Mrs. Davidson led the way across the flashing safety crosswalk at Beach Blvd. Passing that landmark sign, student pairs continued through the park, admiring sculptures, and going beyond Gulfport Senior Center/Theater.

Arriving at 10 a.m., Ms. Cailey met us just as the community library was opening. An enthusiastic librarian, she invited our group to the reading garden for a story about a wee, winged creature called a Snatchabook, who is not scary at all and longing for someone to read to him. Students listened attentively and discussed the plot and characters respectfully.

Ms. Cailey explained anyone could be a library guest and look around, to read and even use the computers Monday through Saturday. But having his own card, as a library patron, a student can choose books to borrow from the community's large easy reader collection. Taken home, these books can be read by students and have stories read to them. A few families had already applied (just bring a utility bill to verify address) and these students proudly carried their own card.

As we toured, the reference librarian showed us how to search online for books from other Pinellas County libraries too. Reserved books are sent to Gulfport for checkout. Ms. Davidson picked up one from Tarpon Springs and returned 10, mostly adventure stories of Curious George and Piggie. Bring your username & password to these computers for practicing IXL.com, ST Math, Starfall and more learning websites.

Ms. Cailey invited students to her Science Club at the library, which is free on Mondays after school. There's always something exciting going on at the library. One boy in our class returned the next day to participate in Reading to a Therapy Dog. Another student remarked her family was planning to use library computers over the break and she was excited about getting her own library card. Thanking our librarians for expanding our world, hungry for knowledge and adventure, we walked back to school.

A Note from the Library



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
