Next Tuesday night, January 31st, is the Pinellas County Schools Evening of Excellence. This is a special evening recognizing outstanding volunteers, business partners, and educators who support teaching and learning throughout this district. We will be honoring our Business Partner of the Year nominee, Mathnasium and cheering on Miss Kopka, a finalist for Teacher of the Year. The event will be held at Mahaffey Theater in St. Petersburg beginning at 7:00. If you are interested in attending tickets can be purchased for \$10 (\$12 at the door) through the Mahaffey Theater box office. All proceeds from this event support the Pinellas Education Foundation. We wish Miss Kopka much luck as she represents Pinellas County's outstanding teachers and Leila Davis Elementary!

This spring our intermediate students will be taking the Florida Standards Assessment (FSA). Our fourth and fifth graders will be taking the FSA Writing Assessment the week of February 27th. All first and second grade students will be taking the SAT-10 mid-March right after Spring Break. Third, fourth, and fifth grade students will be administered the FSA (ELA and Math) on various dates beginning the end of March through most of April. In addition, our 5th grade students will be taking the State Science Assessment the first week of May. A more detailed testing schedule will be sent home in the coming weeks and will be posted on our school website. Please begin talking with your child about the importance of these tests. Please show confidence in your child's ability to be successful not only in the classroom but also on state and district assessments. Praising a child's hard work and ability gives the child strength and self-confidence to do well. If you have any questions about the SAT-10, FSA, or SSS, please contact your child's teacher.

We have a very busy February ahead of us on campus! Our All Pro Dad's is hosting our sixth annual Daddy/Daughter Dance on February 3rd at 6:30pm. Tickets will be on sale Monday through Wednesday next week before school. Please look for the flyer that came home this week (and on Peachjar) with details about this special night for our daddies and daughters! Davis Love and Kindness Week will be held the week of February 13th. More details will be coming about this special week around the Davis campus.

Finally, I want to remind families that safety is a top priority and I appreciate everyone abiding by our policies and helping to maintain a safe learning environment for all our students. Just a few reminders:

- There is NO student drop off/pick up in the bus circle. Parents are asked to use the car circle for drop off and pick up each day. The bus circle is reserved for staff parking and for our buses and day care vans to pick up and drop off students each day.
- We are lucky to have a wonderful partnership with the church next door. The church parking lot is NOT a place for students to wait for parent pick up. We have no school staff supervising on the church property after school and it is dangerous for students to be waiting in a parking lot unsupervised. Furthermore, if you allow your child to play in the church field after school, please be mindful and respectful of the church property and supervise your child. Students should not be digging holes, climbing through bushes, playing near the retention pond, playing with sticks/branches, etc. after dismissal.
- The Clearwater Police Department will be enforcing the "no left turn" during arrival and dismissal times. Please make sure you are only making right hand turns from the car circle onto Landmark.
- All visitors MUST sign in at the front office when visiting campus. A visitor badge MUST be displayed while on campus.

<u>New online application process for Pinellas County</u> <u>Schools Pre-K and VPK</u>

Pinellas County Schools is starting a new, more convenient online application process for Prekindergarten for 3 year olds and Voluntary Prekindergarten. In the past, parents had to visit elementary schools to apply for a seat. March 20-April 9, parents will be able to apply online for Pre-K 3 and VPK for the 2017-18 school year. Pre-K 3 is for children who will be 3 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2017. VPK is for children who will be 4 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2017. VPK is a state program. The first three hours of the day are free. Families interested in VPK will also need to apply for a Certificate of Eligibility (voucher) from the Early Learning Coalition at www.vpkpinellas.net. Parents can apply for a voucher now. Parents will not need a voucher for Pre-K 3. For information about Pre-K 3, visit www.pcsb.org/prek3 or call 727-588-6000 ext. 2184.
