EDUCATIONAL DIAGNOSTICIAN

MAJOR FUNCTION:

Educational Diagnosticians serve as a resource to schools, students and parents. Responsibilities include assisting teams in interpreting universal screening results; determining students in need of tier 2 and tier 3 interventions; selecting research based interventions; assisting with progress monitoring; and administering individual diagnostic assessments.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Serves as member of School-Based Intervention Team
- Assists school teams in reviewing and interpreting results of universal screenings
- Reviews individual student records as needed
- Assists school teams in identifying students in need of tier 2 and 3 interventions
- Demonstrates working knowledge of current curriculum
- Demonstrates thorough knowledge of research based interventions and is able to select appropriate interventions to address student deficits
- Participates in problem solving
- Administers and interprets progress monitoring to determine students' response to intervention
- Displays progress monitoring data in graphic formats
- Assists school teams in following students' progress and recommending changes in types or intensity of interventions
- May conduct classroom observations to assist in supporting teachers in student assessment, progress monitoring, and intervention integrity
- Demonstrates working knowledge of differentiated instruction
- May participate in parent conferences, 504 plan meetings, eligibility determination and IEP meetings
- Conducts formal and informal training with school staff related to assessment, interventions, progress monitoring, and data driven decision making
- Conducts individual student evaluations
- Completes reports interpreting evaluation results
- Collects and submits data on services provided to students and schools
- Pursues own professional development related to improving student achievement
- Performs related duties, as required

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Master's degree in education. Meet certification requirements with emphasis on reading and/or exceptionalities as required by the State Department of Education. Successful teaching experience. Clinical experience.

PREFERRED:

Reading endorsement, or willingness to obtain reading endorsement.
