MAJOR FUNCTION:

Instructional position responsible for conducting, planning and organizing a sound physical education program in one or more elementary schools.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Coordinates program with countywide guides and individual school needs.
- Plans for and directs the elementary physical education program in one or more schools.
- Trains and coordinates the activities of teacher aides assigned to the schools involved.
- Recommends the purchase of physical education supplies and equipment.
- Participates in a countywide in-service program for physical education specialists.
- Works with elementary principals in establishing schedules.
- Performs other related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's degree with certification in Physical Education K-6 or K-12. Student teaching or previous teaching experience on the elementary level.
