BUS DRIVER RELIEF / TRAINING ASSISTANT

MAJOR FUNCTION:

Performs skilled work in the operation of school buses transporting students to and from public schools or facilities. Assists with school bus driver training and mentors new drivers. Performs other related tasks to include updating of route and student information, and preparation of bus inspection, accident/crash, and incident reports. Work is performed under general supervision and direction.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Replaces regularly assigned school bus drivers when they are absent from work, transporting students to and from schools or facilities following a preplanned route and time schedule.
- Performs all other duties required of regular school bus drivers.
- Assists with the training of new school bus drivers and in-service training of drivers, on an "as required" basis.
- Mentors new drivers after they complete the Basic School Bus Driver Training Course and begin work
 at a school bus compound. Monitors the progress of new drivers and works closely with them for up
 to three (3) months to assure a successful transition from the training class.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from high school or possession of a GED required. One (1) year or more experience as a school bus driver with Pinellas County Schools. Must possess and maintain a valid Florida class "B" commercial driver's license with passenger and school bus endorsements. Must hold a current State Medical Examiner's Certificate issued by a Pinellas County School Board approved physician. Satisfactory completion of twelve (12) hours of in-service training on student behavior management required. Must satisfactorily complete the School Bus Driver Trainer Certification Course conducted by the State Department of Education within one (1) year of being placed in the position.
