**CAFETERIA ATTENDANT**

**MAJOR FUNCTION:**

Performs routine duties in a school cafeteria assisting in the orderly conduct of meals, monitoring student conduct prior to and during mealtimes and reporting noncompliance of rules and regulations. Work is performed under direct supervision of an Administrator and is reviewed.

**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Assists children in making their mealtime as pleasant and rewarding as possible by insuring compliance with health, safety and school rules and regulations; assists with routine mealtime problems; encourages good eating habits.
- Assures tables and floors are free from food and papers at the completion of meals; coordinates children volunteering in cleaning and washing of tables.
- Maintains order; notes those not observing rules and reports them to an administrator.
- Performs related work as required.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Willingness to work with children.
