APPLIANCE / REFRIGERATION TECHNICIAN-JOURNEYMAN

MAJOR FUNCTION:

Performs skilled journeyman level work in the installation, diagnosis, repair, and preventive maintenance of commercial and domestic major and small appliances and equipment in the school's food services, culinary arts, home economics and warehouse areas. Responsibilities include training and lead direction of helpers, and responsibility for completion of assigned tasks. Work is performed independently under general direction, in accordance with specifications and accepted standards and procedures of the trade.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Leads, trains, prioritizes assignments, and delegates work to helpers involved in the installation, maintenance and repair of small and major appliances, and refrigeration systems.
- Performs installation, repairs, modifications, and scheduled preventive maintenance on appliances and equipment, such as compressors, condensers, walk-in refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, system controls, washing machines and dryers, dish conveyors, freezers, pulpers, steamers, ice machines, water softeners, vending machines, etc.
- Reads and interprets blueprints, diagrams, sketches and schematics as they relate to the appliance repair, and the refrigeration trade.
- Performs "trouble-shooting" of malfunctioning or inoperative equipment and control circuitry; diagnoses problems and completes repairs as necessary.
- Applies refrigeration, electrical, plumbing and mechanical knowledge of refrigerators, gas and electric appliances, steam equipment and related food production equipment; repairs gas and refrigeration leaks; does acetylene welding and "hot soldering" of lines, as necessary.
- Operates a truck in the field to handle emergency and routine service problems.
- Performs heavy lifting on a routine basis.
- May redesign existing equipment as required to update system for more efficient operation or safety reasons; remove obsolete equipment and install replacement units.
- Cleans boilers, steamers and related equipment, using strong chemicals, as needed.
- Completes work orders as appropriate for documentation of task completion.
- Performs other related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from high school or possession of a GED, plus four (4) years progressively responsible experience in commercial and domestic major and small appliance and refrigeration repair, primarily related to food services operations, and performing most of the duties and responsibilities stated above. The successful completion of up to two (2) years of verifiable formal training in the trade (vocational, military, or indentured apprentice school) may be substituted for a like amount of the experience requirement. Possession of a valid State of Florida Class E noncommercial driver's license and any other license as may be required by law.
