**ELECTRICIAN-JOURNEYMAN**

**MAJOR FUNCTION:**

Performs lead, skilled journeyman level in installation, maintenance, and repair of a variety of electrical systems, appliances, and equipment. Leads subordinates and maintains responsibility for satisfactory completion of tasks. Work is performed independently and reviewed upon completion for conformance with instructions, established standards, and electrical codes.

**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Performs journeyman level duties in installation, repair, alteration, and maintenance of wiring systems, switch panels, flood lights, ornamental lights, and other electrical fixtures and equipment; installs and makes electrical repairs to specialized equipment; does electrical and some mechanical work in repairing and replacing parts; uses specialized tools of trade.
- Leads and trains subordinates in all above functions; maintains time and work records; makes preliminary estimates of time and materials.
- Applies knowledge of standard practices, methods, tools, and materials of electrical trade, of local and national electrical code; of safety precautions and hazards of trade.
- Locates and adjusts defects in electrical systems and equipment; interprets electrical diagrams and blueprints.
- Applies journeyman level skill in the use and care of tools of the electrical trade.
- Performs related work as required.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Graduation from high school or possession of a GED, supplemented by formal training in the electrical trade, plus four (4) years progressively responsible work experience as a electrician. The successful completion of up to two (2) years of verifiable formal training in the trade (vocational, military, or indentured apprentice school) may be substituted for a like amount of the experience requirement. Possession of a valid State of Florida Class E noncommercial driver's license, and any other license as may be required by law.
