PAINTER

MAJOR FUNCTION:

Performs semi-skilled painting work of interior and exterior buildings, fixtures, equipment and miscellaneous items. Assists journeyman Painter in major projects, but performs minor assignments independently from oral or written instructions. Work is performed under general supervision and reviewed during progress or upon completion for conformity to established specifications and accepted standards and procedures of the painting trade.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Prepares surfaces to be painted; removes dirt, scales, rust, old paint, grease and other materials; scrapes, sands and applies sizing.
- Applies paint to interiors and exteriors of buildings, furniture and equipment using paint spray guns and brushes.
- Stains, shelving, benches, tables and cabinets prior to lacquering or varnishing.
- Mixes and matches paints, varnishes, enamels, lacquers, and paint and varnish removers.
- Cleans and maintains brushes, spray guns, and other tools and equipment of the paint trade.
- Lifts heavy objects and equipment, and works at high levels of elevation on a routine basis; rigs and erects scaffolding; hauls and sets up ladders.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from high school or possession of a GED, plus two (2) years experience in the painting trade, performing most of the above mentioned duties and responsibilities. The successful completion of up to two (2) years of verifiable formal training in the trade (vocational, military, indentured apprentice school) may be substituted for a like amount of the experience requirement. Possession of a State of Florida Class E noncommercial driver's license, and any other license as may be required by law.
