(Exceptional Student Education Secondary Level)

MAJOR FUNCTION:

Facilitates learning, allocates resources, monitors classroom achievement results and works to continually improve the learning processes for all students. The position is responsible for the development, leadership and management of an Exceptional Student Education (ESE) department support system that is aligned with the Curriculum Services and school improvement process.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Monitors student assessment results of ESE High School students (Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FCAT), HighSchool Competency Test (HSCT) alternative assessment).
- Maintains follow-up of students who have received supported employment services.
- Collects and maintains data on the results of Career Assessment recommendations.
- Provides ESE job follow-up for selected high schools.
- Serves as Curriculum Services Connector.
- Provides periodic monitoring of high school matrices/ Individual Education Plan (IEP)'s to ensure alignment.
- Assists with departmental initiatives as needed (i.e., IEP training, New Teacher Orientation (NTO), discipline reviews, etc.).
- Serves as ESE Liaison in the district reading/literacy initiative.
- Assists teachers in maintaining a classroom atmosphere conducive to learning and highest student achievement.
- Involves stakeholders in the development of shared vision, mission and goals.
- Effectively communicates and implements classroom expectations to all stakeholders.
- Demonstrates involvement in school, classroom and community activities working toward continual improvement.
- Regularly reports progress on department goals and processes.
- Consistently models cooperation and teamwork through professionalism.
- Deals professionally and appropriately with all stakeholders.
- Develops and communicates long and short-term department plans and goals.
- Develops, monitors and communicates evaluation and measurement systems for student achievement.
- Allocates time and resources consistent with the department plan.
- Builds, maintains and improves student, parent and community partnerships.
- Provides for input from students and parents for development of improvement strategies.
- Considers next level/course expectations and levels of satisfaction in determining department aim.
- Aggregates, maintains and monitors customer satisfaction and dissatisfaction data to help determine needs and priorities.
- Maintains and monitors an information system that supports the department goals.
- Analyzes and uses relevant data for decision making.
- Aligns department plans with the Curriculum Services division plan.
- Uses comparison and benchmarking data in the analysis of department performance.
- Trains teachers in quality terms, tools and techniques by modeling.

- Uses PDSA process to research, evaluate, design and deliver optimum assistance with departmental initiatives.
- Ensures that personal processes are aligned to team/departmental and school goals.
- Secures and effectively utilizes available resources.
- Summarizes and reports current levels and trends in department processes and activities.
- Summarizes and reports improvement trends as a result of department improvement initiatives.
- Summarizes and reports current levels and trends in classroom support services (textbooks, supplies, budget).
- Summarizes and reports trends in quality of entering and leaving students.
- · Performs related duties as required.
