MAJOR FUNCTION:

Provides assistance to the K-12 Social Studies Supervisor in curriculum development and training involving curriculum, instruction, and assessment strategies that improve student achievement in the K-12 Social Studies/Multicultural program. Provides assistance to school-based administrators and teachers in implementing effective K-12 social studies/multicultural programs, including curriculum, instruction, assessment, materials, instructional technology and the evaluation of programs. Serves as a multicultural liaison between the district office and schools.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBLITIES:

- Maintains a professional development plan and engages in professional activities.
- Serves as a multicultural liaison to schools.
- May serve as a Curriculum Services school connector.
- Represents social studies on cross-functional teams.
- Represents the district at state, regional conferences on educational research and effective practices in the teaching of social studies.
- Serves as liaison with community groups, parents, colleges and universities and other agencies.
- Develops and promotes the use of integrated management systems.
- Provides oversight for development of curriculum and material for social studies and multicultural related courses.
- Assists in research and development of teaching and learning strategies related to increased student achievement in social studies classes.
- Assists in development and monitoring of assessments aligned to the Sunshine State Standards, Grade Level Expectations, Pinellas County Schools Student Expectations (PCSSE), and Pinellas County course descriptions.
- Assists in Economics Quiz Bowl competition for middle schools.
- Provides instruction for social studies teachers in effective teaching and learning strategies.
- Assists in training in the use of data to improve instruction in the area of social studies and multicultural courses.
- Assists in development of assessments for social studies Essential Learnings.
- Provides input from students, parents and business partners in the development of social studies/multicultural programs and improvement strategies.
- Demonstrates involvement in school, classroom and community activities working toward continual improvement.
- Collects, aggregates, maintains and monitors customer satisfaction data to help adjust program development, implementation and improvement.
- Provides stakeholders with timely access to information and data for program improvement and student achievement.
- Uses Plan, Do, Study, Act (PDSA) process to research, evaluate, design and deliver optimum assistance with departmental and division initiatives.

- Maintains, monitors and collects data for an information system that supports program development, improvement and evaluation.

- Monitors and communicates trend, benchmark and comparison data in the areas of curriculum, instruction, assessment and improvement in social studies/multicultural programs.
- Provides support and materials for students and teachers in special social studies/multicultural programs as well as in general education.
- Coordinates professional training for social studies teachers and administrators.
- Encourages teachers' involvement, empowerment, responsibility and innovation in school improvement activities.
- Provides support for articulation of ESOL and ESE guidelines and pedagogy in social studies programs.
- Recognizes contributions to program goal achievement.
- Provides program development, professional development and classroom coaching for social studies teachers
- Assists schools in securing appropriate instructional materials.
- Provides for the evaluation and improvement of social studies/multicultural programs.
- Assist teachers with creating classroom-learning systems.
- Assist schools with articulation of social studies essential learning's.
- Systematically collects, analyzes and reports data to support decision-making in order to review and improve project action plans, timelines, processes and systems.
- Performs other related duties as required.

Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. Possession of, or eligible for, a valid regular Florida Educator Certificate in Elementary Education. At least three (3) years of successful teaching in elementary social studies.
